- Goal Area 5: Education and Job Skills to Lead an Independent Life

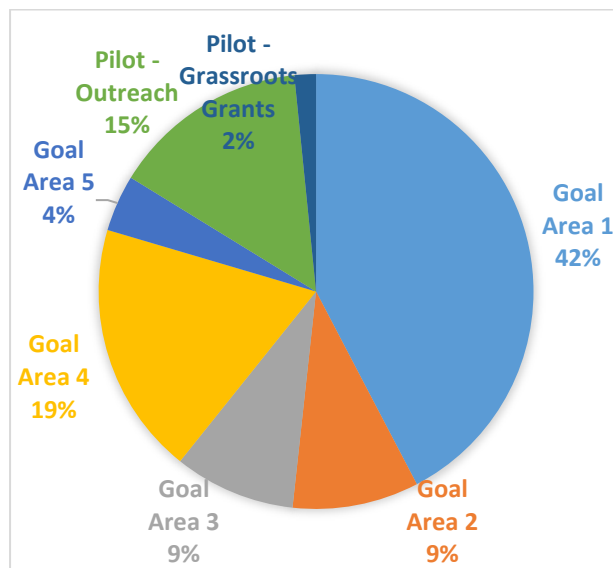


Figure 1 Funding Recommendations by Goal Area
